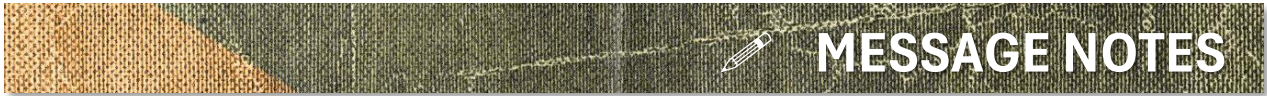




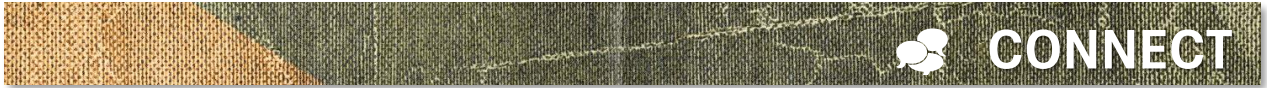

Children of God

GALATIANS 3:15-4:7



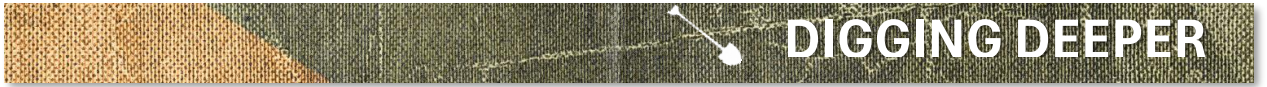
1. We are **imprisoned** by the law. (Galatians 3:21-23)
2. We become **children** of God by **faith** in Jesus. (Galatians 3:24-29)
3. We will live as **slaves** or **sons**. (Galatians 4:1-7)
 - **Faith** or **Works**
 - **Freedom** or **Rules**
 - **Abundance** or **Scarcity**



What stood out to you in the sermon? What was significant or interesting to you?

The pastor discussed that sons live in abundance and slaves live in scarcity and gave several examples to illustrate this. How have you seen these mindsets lived out in your church experiences? How have they manifested in your life?

The pastor mentioned three contrasts between followers who choose to live as slaves or sons. In which area do you live most like a son? In which are you most “slave-like”? Why?



Do you tend to view life from a mindset of the glass being half empty or the glass being half full?

Read **Romans 7:7-13**. What questions come to your mind as you read this section?

How does the Law highlight a works, rules, and scarcity mindset?

Based on **Romans 7:13**, what is the value of the Law? Is it helpful? How so?

Read **Romans 8:31–39**. What promises and words of hope do you see in this passage?

Romans 8:32 says, “He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?” What does this mean for those who have been adopted as God’s children?

How does the phrase “graciously give us all things” change your scarcity mindset?

Reflect on your mindset regarding God's provision and blessings. How does your perception of God's abundance impact your generosity, service to others, and trust in His provision?
